Your participation and enthusiasm are greatly appreciated.

Participation Requirements

- 1. Complete new volunteer orientation (Approximately 2 hours)
- 2. Sign a release form for a Criminal Background check, read and sign the Standards of Behavior and Confidentiality agreements.
- 3. Please contact Occupational Health (208-265-1284) to schedule an appointment for your Drug Screen and Immunity Review. You will receive TB testing, drug screening, and blood work if your immunization records are unavailable. These procedures are completed by our Occupational Health department. Drug screening is not required for Junior Volunteers. Each year Bonner General Health offers the flu vaccination free to employees and volunteers. If you decline to have your flu shot, you will be required to wear a mask during the flu season (determined by Panhandle Health).
- 4. Participate in annual education (individual study)
- 5. Your uniform is provided for you. You may wear the BGH Volunteer polo shirt, smock, or vest. If wearing a shirt underneath, it must be white or offwhite with sleeves, Long pants (at least to ankle length), or skirt (knee length) in black, navy blue (NO blue denim), brown, tan, or white may be worn.
- 6. Wear official BGH name tag at all times while volunteering
- 7. Record all volunteer time (you may count your driving time up to 30 min.)
